## Senior Youth

### Ages: 12 to 16 years old

### Section

- 1. Small flower arrangement in a vase, using real flowers. **No** higher than 12 inches including the vase.
- 2. Three (3) coneflowers in a jar.
- 3. Colourful arrangement of flowers in a beach pail.
- 4. Three (3) dahlias over 2 inches in diameter arranged in a vase.

# **Junior Youth**

## Ages: 9 to 11 years old

## Section

- 5. Three (3) marigold blooms 2 inches or less in diameter with leaves arranged in a small vase.
- 6. Small flower arrangement, using real flowers, in a coffee mug. No higher than 12 inches.
- 7. An arrangement of assorted leaves and any single flower in a vase.
- 8. One (1) sunflower, less than 7 inches in diameter in a glass jar.

#### Ages: 6 to 8 years old

#### Section

- 9. Three (3) hosta leaves, any colour arranged in a glass jar.
- 10. Small flower arrangement, using real flowers, in a coffee mug. No higher than 12 inches
- 11. Any flower in bloom grown from a bulb, corm, or tuber in a suitable container.
- 12. Weeds in bloom 4 to 6 arranged in a jar.

#### Ages: 3 to 5 years old

Ask mommy or daddy to help you water all your entries.

#### Section

- 13. Three (3) blooms of Rudbeckia (Black-eyed Susan) in a glass jar.
- 14. Small flower arrangement, using real flowers, in a coffee mug. No higher than 12 inches
- 15. One (1) sunflower bloom, no more than 5 inches in diameter, in a suitable glass jar.
- 16. Six (6) or seven (7) wildflowers and/or weeds in bloom arranged in a vase.
