CLASS 10: QUILTING

GENERAL:

- 1. All articles for exhibit in this class must be the handiwork of the exhibitor. All quilts must be quilted by hand (HQ), machine (MQ) or both. MQ must state "Domestic" or "Long Arm" on extra tag. Quilting is defined as a running stitch that passes through top, batting and backing. Tied quilts are not eligible.
- 2. Items must be completed after August 2015 and may not be submitted more than twice for judging.
- 3. All items must be in good condition and clean. Quilts must be free of any odours such as tobacco, perfume, mildew, pet incomplete, soiled, stained or damaged quilts will NOT be judged.
- 4. Exhibitor may only make one entry per section.
- 5. All decisions of judge(s) are final. Committee reserves the right to reject any entry or to move a quilt into a different category. Quilts are judged on general appearance, design and workmanship in accordance with the OAAS Judging Standards.
- 6. Champion and Reserve Champion Rosettes will be awarded for to those quilts judged to be superior in general appearance, design and workmanship in both Hand Quilting and Machine Quilting. All quilts entered into this class are eligible.
- 7. Sample of material must be attached (SMA)

 Indicate quilted on Domestic or Longarm on back of tag.

- 4. Large Bed Quilts pieced and appliqued, embroidery or combination Machine Quil Prize: \$0 Competes for OAAS Machine quilting competition Indicate quilted on Domestic or Longarm on back of tag.
- Large Bed Quilts hand applique and or hand embroidery Hand Quilted Competes for OAAS Hand Qulting Competition
- 6. Large Bed Quilts Machine applique and/or Machine embroidery Machine Quilted Competes for OAAS quilting competition Indicate quilted on Domestic or Longarm on back of tag.
- 7. Large Bed Quilts Any other technique not listed Hand or Machine Quilted Competes for OAAS Hand or Machine quilting competitions
 If done by machine, indicate quilted on a Domestice or Longarm on back of tag.
- 8. Large Bed Quilts Any technique, top completed by entrant, quilted by another Does NOT qualify for OAAS quilting competitions. May be quilted by hand or machine. If done by machine, indicate quilted on a Domestice or Longarm on back of tag.

- 9. Small Bed Quilts pieced, traditional design, pattern named Hand Quilted Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter
- **10.** Small Bed Quilts pieced, traditional design, pattern named Machine quilted Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter Please note type of machine used for quilting domestic, or long arm
- 11. Small Bed Quilts pieced, traditional design, pattern named
 Hand or Machine quilted by person other than entrant
 Please note type of machine used for machine quilting domestic or longarm
 Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter
- **12.** Small Bed Quilts pieced and appliqued, embroidery or combination Hand Quilted Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter
- 13. Small Bed Quilts pieced and applique, embroidery or combination Machine Quilt Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter Please note type of machine used for quilting domestic or longarm
- 14. Small Bed Quilts pieced and applique, embroidery or combination Hand or Machine quilted by person other than entrant Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter Please note type of machine used for quilting domestic or longarm
- **15.** Small Bed Quilts hand applique and/or hand embroidery Hand Quilted Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter

16. Small Bed Quilts - Machine applique and/or machine embroidery - Machine quilted

Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter

Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

17. Small Bed Quilts - machine applique and/or machine embroidery

Hand or Machine quilted by person other than entrant

Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter

If machine quilted, please note the type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

18. Small Bed Quilts - any other technique not listed - Hand or Machine Quilted

Minimum 60 inches x 70 inches, to less than 324 inches perimeter

If machine quilted, please note the type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

LARGE LAP OR WALL QUILTS:

19. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - pieced - Hand quilted

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve

20. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - Pieced - Machine quilted

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

21. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - pieced - Hand or Machine quilted by other than entrant

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

22. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - predominantly applique (hand or machine) - Hand Quilted

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve

23. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - predominantly applique (hand or machine) - Machine Quilted 40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

24. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - predominantly applique (hand or machine)

Hand or Machine quilted by person other than entrant

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

25. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - mixed techniques - Hand guilted

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve

26. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - mixed techniques - Machine guilted

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

27. Large Lap or Wall Quilts - mixed techniques

Hand or Machine guillted by person other than entrant

40 inches TO 60 inches width, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

SMALL LAP OR WALL QUILTS:

28. Small Lap or Wall Quilts - Pieced - Hand quilted

Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve

29. Small Lap or Wall Quilts - pieced - Machine guilted

Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

- 30. Small Lap or Wall Quilts pieced Hand or machine quilted by other than entrant
 - Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm
- 31. Small Lap or Wall Quilts predominantly applique (hand or machine) Hand Quilted Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve
- 32. Small Lap or Wall Quilts predominantly applique (hand or machine) Machine Quilted Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting domestic or longarm
- 33. Small Lap or Wall Quilts predominantly applique (hand or machine)
 - Hand or machine quilted by person other than entrant
 - Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm
- 34. Small Lap or Wall Quilts mixed techniques Hand quilted

Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve

35. Small Lap or Wall Quilts - mixed techniques - Machine quilted

Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve Please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

36. Small Lap or Wall Quilts - mixed techniques

Hand or Machine guilted by person other than applicant

Less than 40 inches wide, no limit on length; wall quilts must have hanging sleeve If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

BEGINNER QUILTS:

37. Beginner Quilts - any technique, any size - Hand or Machine quilted

A beginner is defined as any quilter who has been quilting for less than 2 years.

Not less than 40 inches in width

If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

38. Beginner Quilts - any technique, any size

Hand or Machine quilted by person other than entrant - not less than 40 inches in width A beginner is defined as any quilter who has been quilting for less than 2 years. If machine quilted, please note type of machine used for quilting - domestic or longarm

SPECIALTY QUILTING:

39. Specialty Quilting - Art/Landscape Quilt - Hand or Machine Quilted Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0

May use several techniques but must be the entrant's original design

40. Specialty Quilting - Novelty Quilt - Hand or Machine quilted Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0

Any technique not previously listed (ie Yo-Yo, Tied, Photo, Wholecloth, etc)

- **41.** Specialty Quilting Table Runner any technique Hand or Machine quilted Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0
- 42. Specialty Quilting Cushion, not larger than 24 inches on any side Hand or Machine quilted Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0
- **43.** Specialty Quilting Placemats (2), any technique Hand or Machine quilted Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0
- 44. Specialty Quilting Quilt Block, mounted on bristol board, back of block to be accessible Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0

- 45. Specialty Quilting Article of quilted clothing Prizes: 1st: \$10, 2nd: \$8, 3rd: \$6, others: \$0
- 47. Marilyn Johnson Memorial Special Any hand made item with a cat theme Prizes: 1st: \$25, 2nd:

\$15, 3rd: \$10, 4th: \$0
