- 1. Rose, 1 stem, more than 1 bloom with foliage attached, in a vase
- 2. Single rose, floating in a wine glass
- 3. Cosmos, 5 blooms, any colour or colours
- 4. Dahlia, 3 blooms, up to 4 inches, in vase
- 5. Heurchera (Coral Bells) leaves, 3 stems
- 6. Snapdragons, 3 spikes any colours
- 7. Sunflower, any variety, 1 bloom in a container under 6 inches
- 8. Rudbecka (Black Eyed Susan) 3 stems in a jar
- 9. 3 Clematis blooms floating in a suitable bowl of water
- 10. Hosta, any colour 3 leaves in a jar
- 11. Day lily, 1 stem
- 12. Marigolds, 3 blooms, under 3", with foliage attached
- 13. 3 Gladiolus in bloom, in a suitable container using floral foam
- 14. Mums, 3 stems with foliage in a glass jar
- 15. 1 head hydrangea in a glass jar
- 16. Sedum 3 stems
- 17. 3 Zinnias with own foliage
- 18. Cleome, 3 stems, any colour
- 19. 5 Pansies in your choice of container
- 20. 3 stems of perenneal Phlox, any colour
- 21. Nature's Way, wild flower bouquet in any container
- 22. All White, white only for this entry, except foliage, with floral foam & white container
- 23. 3 stems of any herb, named
