5. Carrots, 5, long, tops ¼ inch (*½ cm*) above crown
6. Carrots, 5, short, tops ¼ inch (*½ cm*) above crown
7. Corn, 3, sweet, 1/2 husk removed from tip to butt
8. Cucumbers, 3, slicing, ¼ inch (*½ cm*) of stem
9. Cucumbers, 3, pickling, ¼ inch (*½ cm*) of stem
10. Garlic Buds, 3
11. Onions, 5 green, in a bunch
12. Onions, 3 yellow, roots trimmed, not peeled
13. Onions, 3 red, roots trimmed not peeled
14. Onions, 1 Spanish
15. Peppers, 3, green, ¼ inch (*½ cm*) of stem left on
16. Peppers, 3, red, ¼ inch (*½ cm*) of stem left on
17. Potatoes, 3, white, brushed, not washed
18. Potatoes, 3 red, brushed, not washed
19. Potatoes, 3, yellow, brushed, not washed
20. Tomatoes, 3, red, with stems attached
21. Tomatoes, 3, green, with stems attached
22. Tomatoes, 5, plum, with stems attached
23. Tomatoes, 5, cherry, red, with stems attached
