

## Homecraft Division Rules and Regulations



### Membership Fees

1. The **Membership fee** must accompany the entry form of all new and returning Exhibitors except for those listed above.
2. The entry deadline is Monday, August 19, 2019 at 6:00 pm.
3. The Fair office hours will be Monday, August 19, 2019 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm to receive forms and payments.
4. The Homecraft Committee will be at the Exhibition Hall to receive entry forms and fees and to give you your exhibitor number and tags, if needed, on the Monday, August 19<sup>th</sup>, from 7:00 to 9:00 pm, and the Thursday, August 22, 2019, evening from 6:00 to 9:00 pm.

### Exhibits

1. Exhibitors in Classes 1 and 3 **MUST** be the actual grower unless otherwise stated.
2. All exhibits submitted **MUST** be the work of the exhibitor.
3. Dirty, defaced or old work will not be judged.
4. No prizes unless the exhibit is worthy
5. No item can be exhibited more than 2 years in a row
6. You may enter only 1 exhibit per section in a class
7. Exhibits must be placed on either Thursday, August 22, 2019 evening between 6:00 pm and 9:00 pm or Friday, August 23, 2019 morning between 8:00 am and 9:30 am.
8. Absolutely **NO** exhibits will be **accepted after** the 9:30 am deadline on Friday, August 23, 2019 morning.
9. The **removal of any** exhibit **before** 4:00 pm on Sunday, August 25, 2019 **without the consent** of the Homecraft Secretary, **will forfeit the prize money.**

### Entry Forms and Tags

1. Entry Forms Availability:

2. Entry Tags Availability:
  - Monday, August 12, 2019 until Thursday evening of Fair weekend, August 22, 2019 at 9:00 pm. Tags will only be given out once entry form is received.

  - The entry deadline is Monday, August 19, 2019 at 6:00 pm.
3. Please fill in entry forms and tags very carefully.
4. Don't forget to have the age visible on the top portion of the tag for all youth classes. All youth entry tags must be signed at the bottom by the parent/guardian.

### **Judging**

1. Judging begins after 10:00 am on Friday morning. The Exhibit hall will be closed to the public from 9:30 am until 4:00 pm. After 4:00 pm the hall will be open for viewing.
2. All decisions regarding winning entries and ties are at the discretion of the Judges.
3. In the case of ties the decision will be made based on the number of 1<sup>st</sup>, and/or 2<sup>nd</sup>, and/or 3<sup>rd</sup> places, and this method will break the tie.
4. Please note that the Homecraft organizers and their committees, as well as any other Fair Directors or staff, have NOTHING to do with the outcome of the judging.

### **Ceremonies**

1. The Homecraft Awards ceremony will be held in the Exhibition Hall starting at 3:00 pm, on Sunday, August 25, 2019.
2. The Exhibition Hall closes to the public immediately after the Awards presentation for dismantling of displays until 4:00 pm.
