Age Category Merging: In the event that there are not enough entries in one age category to run a separate competition, the Chesterville Fair reserves the right to merge the affected age category with another. The decision to merge categories will be at the sole discretion of the Chesterville Fair organisers, and all participants will be informed accordingly.

Liability Release: The parent or guardian understands that the Chesterville Fair organisers and associated staff will take reasonable precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants during the Baby Show. However, they acknowledge that participation in the event involves inherent risks. Therefore, the parent or guardian agrees not to hold the Chesterville Fair, its organisers, sponsors, volunteers, or any related individuals liable for any injuries, accidents, or damages that may occur during the Baby Show.

Conduct and Sportsmanship: The parent or guardian acknowledges that the Chesterville Fair is a family-friendly event and agrees to ensure their child's behaviour reflects the spirit of sportsmanship and respect for all participants, volunteers, and spectators. The Chesterville Fair organisers reserve the right to disqualify any child or participant whose conduct is deemed inappropriate or disruptive to the event. The Chesterville Fair organisers reserve the right to disqualify any participant for non-compliance with the rules and guidelines of the Baby Show, or for any reason deemed appropriate by the organisers.
